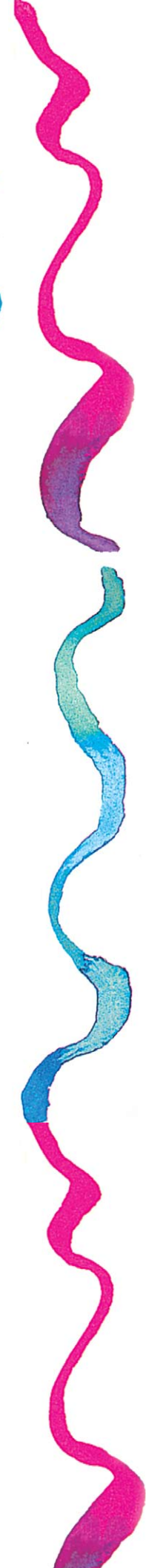
St. Francis Hospice Mission
